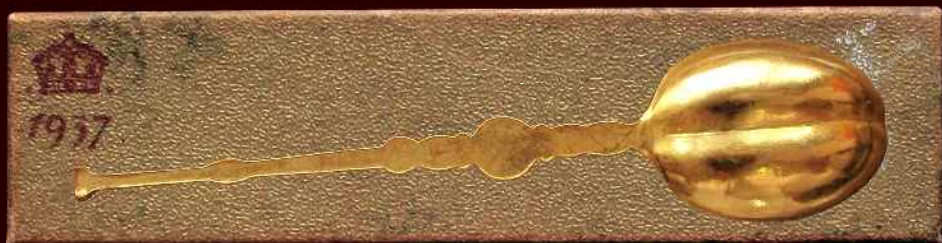

## Ancient Coins (600 BC to AD 700)



1 *Not listed in KM*

**Swastika Coin, Jhabua State, Gopal Singh** (AD 1840-1895), Copper, **Swastika** on obv, leaves on rev (not listed in KM). *The Swastika is re-struck on the rev type of leaves type. About Extremely Fine, Rare.*

Estimate: ₹ 2,000-3,000



2 *Unusual*

**Mauryas** (3rd century BC), Copper, 10.21 g, **Stupa**, the usual Buddhist Stupa with the Door-way of a Stupa designed between the two tree in railings on either side of the Stupa design on front in a tablet-like fashion. The back side is blank. *Unusual item with an implication on religious history of India. Rare.*

Such portable Stupas are reported to be found along with the Punch-marked coins of the Mauryas and also with the Uninscribed cast Mauryan coins from northern India. The find indicates that such Stupas belong to rich businessmen of the period who used to travel a lot and carried these Stupas for personal worship and were kept in money bags along with coins.

**Kingdom of Thrace, Lysimachus**, Gold, 8.26 g, **Stater**. Diademed head of deified Alexander right, with horn of Ammon / BASILEWS LYSIMAXOY, Athena enthroned left, holding Nike on extended right hand & resting left elbow on shield propped against throne, **Th C M** monogram in inner left field, **TO** on throne, ornate trident in ex. *Almost UNC for the type, Extremely Rare.*

4 *Rare*

**Indo-Greeks, Antimachos II Nikephoros** (c. 174-165 BC), Silver, 2.36g, **Drachm**, Bilingual series, MT monogram to left, Greek legend around **BASILEWS NIKHFOROU ANTIMACOU**, Goddess Nike advancing left, holding palm in outstretched right hand and fillet in left on obv. Kharoshthi legend, *Maha Rajasa jayadharasa Amtimakasa*, Antimachos, wearing diadem and helmet on horse rearing right on rev. (Bop Series 1C). *Very Fine+, Rare.*

5 *Rare*

**Indo-Greeks, Menander I**, Silver **Drachm**, Indian Standard, helmeted bust of the king to right with Greek legend on obv., Pallas standing left holding shield on raised right arm and hurling thunderbolt, with Kharoshthi legend around on rev (Mitch 1780). *Very Fine+, Rare.*

6 **City-State of Erikutch**, 2nd century BC, Copper, 2.99 g, die-struck type with a tree in railing and a bow with an arrow and Brahmi legend between the two reading, *erikutcha* (i.e. of Erikutch) on obv, a bow and an arrow with a tree in railing on rev. Both the sides of the coin are with full motifs particularly the reverse which is mostly defaced on all the known coins. *About Extremely Fine, Scarce.*

**Senas of Erikutch** (2nd century BC), Copper, 4.92 g, Punch-marked type with two punches having Brahmi legend reading, *Rajno Saha / sa senasa*. *A punch of a standard in a railing on rev. Broad flan, About Extremely Fine, Rare in this size.*

8 *Rare in this grade*

**Satavahanas, Gotamiputra Satakarni** (1st century AD), Silver, 2.29 g, **Dramma**, the obv shows a three arched hill and Brahmi legend around reading, *rajno gotamiputasa siri satakanisa*. The rev has the usual Ujjayini symbol with a crescent at top. *The coin is unusual as it seems to be the original issue of the Satavahana ruler without any counter-striking, however, a minute study of the field on the rev indicates that the coin in fact is a counter-struck type with the under-type of Nahapana still visible on rev. Used as a pendent at that time. An excellent example of re-striking, Almost Mint State, Rare in this grade.*

9 *Unpublished and First Known Coin*

**Pre-Satavahanas of Western India**, 1st century BC, Unknown Ruler, Copper, 3.34 g, an elephant walking to left with left-front leg raised and Brahmi legend at top reading, *rajno ...* on obv, a divine couple standing, facing front. The male figure is holding a huge circular object in his right hand and raised above the shoulder and till the head and can easily be identified with Lord Vishnu and his consort Goddess Lakshmi. *Extremely Fine for the type, Unpublished and First Known Coin, Unique.*

The depiction of Lord Vishnu in this form is quite similar to that found on the silver coins of Indo-Greek ruler Agathocles, found in Afghanistan. On those coins, Lord Krishna and Balaram are depicted on either side with Krishna having a huge Wheel for Sudarshana Chakra placed near his legs and his elder brother on the other side with a plough in his right hand. The similar depiction of Vishnu with his Sudarshan Chakra implies the direct influence of the Indo-Greeks on this coin of western India.

**Pre-Satavahanas**, 1st century BC, Copper, 2.37 g, Uninscribed, a bold Shrivatsa symbol in the centre of a square and Swastikas and Taurines around on obv, a stylized Shrivatsa symbol made of four such symbols around a circle on rev. *Extremely Fine+, Rare.*

11 *Rare*

**Satavahanas, King Satavahana**, 2nd century BC, Copper, 3.93 g, Brahmi legend around Ujjayini symbol on obv, a tree in railing on rev. *Extremely Fine for the type, Rare.*

12 *Rare in this condition*

**Satavahanas, Vasithiputra Pulumavi**, 2nd century AD, Copper, 4.95 g, Nasik type with an elephant standing to right with upraised trunk and Brahmi legend at top on obv, a tree in railing on rev. *Extremely Fine+, Rare in this condition.*

13 **Kushanas, Wima Kadphises**, Copper, **Shiva and Nandi type**, the king standing to left and legend around on obv Hindu God Shiva standing, facing front, reclining on his celestial vehicle, Nandi Bull, Kharoshthi legend around on rev. *Fine+, Scarce.*

14 *Extremely Rare*

**Kushanas, Kanishka I**, Copper, 3.7 g, **Urdhva Linga Shiva type**, the king standing to left with offering in the Fire Altar near his right leg and legend around on obv. Lord Shiva standing with a single head and holding a trident in his right hand, his left hand is hanging by the waist and Greek legend in the right field reading OSHO. *Almost Extremely Rare, Extremely Rare.*

The most outstanding part of the coin is the rev with the Lord Shiva standing and having an **Urdhva Linga** (erect phallus called Ithyphallic Shiva), the pose is quite distinct with his out of proportion Linga shown in a more realistic pose than the unrealistic pose of the same on his gold coins. The out of proportion of the Linga is purposely made to show the characteristic feature of Lord Shiva on such a small coin which could have easily been missed by its holder. It seems that this pose of Shiva is the earliest form which was developed later into a more subtle form of Shiva Linga.

It is for the first time that such a copper coin of this type has appeared in any auction. A similar coin is recorded by Joe Cribb in the British Museum, London. An unusual coin with a very high implications on the religious history of India.

**Gupta Empire, Kumaragupta I** (AD 414-455), Silver, 2.14 g, **Dramma**, portrait type with date of issue reading in Gupta Numerals from outside, Va 100 and 7 (for **Varshe 107** = AD 427); the rev depicts a Garuda in the centre and Brahmi legend around. *Extremely Fine+*, *Very Rare to find a date on the Gupta coin with at such an unusual place.*

20 **Gupta Empire, Skandagupta** (AD 455-478), Silver, **Dramma**, portrait on obv, Garuda on rev (3), and Fire Altar on rev types. *Very Fine*, *Scarce*. 4 coins

AD 836-885), Silver, 3.89 g, **Adivaraha Dramma**, Boar or Varaha as an incarnation of Lord Vishnu facing right with Goddess Prithvi (Earth) as a circular ball resting on his left elbow and the hand is placed on the left knee on obv; Nagari legend on rev reads, *Srimad Adivaraha* (Deyell 7). *Extremely Fine+*, *Broad flan*, *Scarce in this size.*

24 *Rare*

**Chauhanas of Gujarat, Somaladevi**, the Queen of Bhima II of Gujarat (AD 1120-1130), Silver, 4.39 g, **Dramma**, Gadhahiya Bust to right on obv, Nagari legend, *shri soma / la devi* on rev (Deyell 162a). *Very Fine+*, *Rare*.

25 **Shakambari Chowhans of Ajmer, Ajayadeva** (AD 1110-1120), Silver, 4.20 g, **Dramma**, Gadhahiya Goddess Lakshmi seated facing front on obv, Nagari legend, *shri aja / ya deva* on rev (Deyell 179). *Very Fine+*, *Scarce*.

Estimate: ₹ 1,200-1,500



26 **Feudatory Chiefs of Gersoppa - Nagire, Saluva Malla** with the title Rajadhiraja, Silver, 1.92 g, Pagoda, a lion running left with a raised paw and curled tail; Nagari legend reads on rev, *Rajadhiraja* (Mitch 333). *Extremely Fine*, *Scarce*.

27 *Rare*

**Gangas**, 10th century AD, Gold, 3.95 g, **Pagoda**, Elephant Pagoda with an elephant standing to right with hanging trunk on obv and a scroll on rev, uninscribed. *Earliest issue of the Elephant Pagoda, Extremely Fine+, Rare.*

**Yadavas of Devagiri, Singhana deva, Mahadeva and Bhillam deva**, Silver, 0.91 g, 0.88 g, 0.9 g, lion type on obv and Nagari legend on rev. *Very Fine+, Rare as a set of 3 rulers. 3 coins*

**Muhammad Shah I** (AD 1359-1375), Silver, 1.63 g,  $\frac{1}{6}$  **Tanka, Builder of the Faith of God type**, ND (Rajgor# 2528; G&G# BH 31). *Test marks, Very Fine, Rare.*

**Muhammad Shah I**, Silver, 1.77 g,  $\frac{1}{6}$  **Tanka, Abu al Muzaffar type**, ND (G&G# BH 32). *Test marks, Very Fine, Rare.*

Muhammad Shah I, Silver, 1.82 g, **1/6 Tanka**, 778 *Abu al Mugazi* type, AH 778 (G&G# BH 33). *Test marks, Very Fine, Rare.*

While describing the legend on obv of the coin, Goron & Goenka comment that the ruler's *kunya* is not clear, it could also be *abu al muzaffar*. However, the present coin clearly reads it *abu al Mughazi*.

### Jaunpur Sultanate

**Ibrahim Shah** (AD 1402-1440), Gold, 11.42 g, **Tanka**, without Tughra style, *Fi Zaman* type on obv, Jaunpur mint (Rajgor# 2707; G&G# J2). *Almost UNC and Extremely Rare in this grade.*

Ibrahim Shah is the first ruler whose coins are known in Jaunpur Sultanate. It seems that his gold and silver coins were issued after he conquered in to Bengal under the Sultans of Bengal. His coins are modeled on those Bengal issues and are direct result of those coins. Although his gold coins of Tughra style are reported quite often, this type without the Tughra is quite rare.

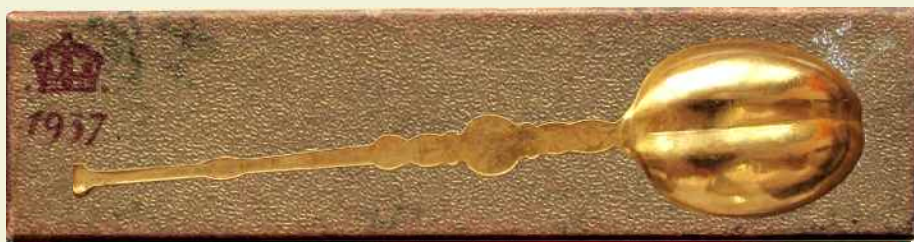

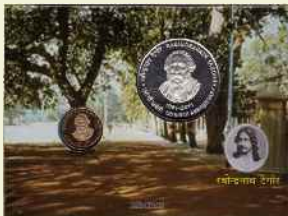
