- 1 **The Swastika Coin, Satavahanas, Satakarni I** (1st century AD), Copper, 4.81 g, **Nasik Lion type**, a big **Swastika** symbol placed above the back of a lion with its tail curled above its back, Brahmī legend around on obv, a tree in railing on rev. *Very Fine, Scarce.*

- 2 **The Swastika Coin, Malwa Sultanate**, Mahmud Shah bin Nasir Shah (AD 1510-1531), Silver, **Tanka**, AH 923 with clock-wise **Swastika** on rev. *Very Fine+, Rare.*

- 3 **The Ganesha Coin Keychain, Thailand, Rama VI, 10 Baht**, Bi-metal, 2012, portrait of the ruler to left on obv, Lord Ganapati seated in the centre with four hands and holding various *Ayudhas*, value around on rev. Commemorating the 100 years of Department of Arts, Thai Era 2554 (AD 2012). *Specially packed in a blister pack and named Souvenir from Thailand, and issued by TalkMoney. Brilliant UNC.*

- 5 **Early Historic Commodity Money** (3rd century BC), Saurashtra region, **Tortoise Bead**, Gold, 0.44 g, 12 x 9 mm, Bead in the shape of a Taurine or a Turtle with a hook made in its neck; the head, the four legs and the tail are made from tiny gold globules. Hollow within and given a fuller raised shape at the main body but quite light in weight. *Interesting and attractive piece of antiquity. Rare.*

- 6 **Punch-marked Coins, Shakya Janapada** (6th century BC), Silver, 6.59 g, 36 x 21 mm, **5 Shana**, Single punch and Scyphate type with a bold wheel symbol punched heavily in the centre, small bankers' marks around on obv, the central symbol is made of 7 ovals placed around a central circle, and enclosed in a circle, uniface (Rajgor Series# 33 but this symbol is not reported by him). *About Extremely Fine+, Rare in this size.*

- 7 **Punch-marked Coins, Shakya Janapada** (6th century BC), Silver, 6.45 g, 27 x 22 x 6 mm, triangular in shape, **5 Shana**, Single punch and Scyphate type with a bold flower symbol punched heavily in the centre, small bankers' marks around on obv, the central symbol is made of a plus-type symbol with dots in the centre, uniface (Rajgor Series# 33 but this symbol is not reported by him). *About Extremely Fine+, Rare in this size.*

Reported from a village called Ratha, located near Kanpur and Lucknow. Unpublished, reported for the first time, Extremely Rare as this Series of Punch-marked coins were never reported earlier.*

- 10 **Punch-marked Coins, Kosala Janapada** (5th century BC), Silver, 1.72 g, ½ **Karshapana**, Four Symbols **AAAB** type, with 3 Triskelis (3 symbols punched from the same punch), and a big Lotus symbol with 6 petals. *A minor counter-mark on the reverse. Reported from a village called Ratha, located near Kanpur and Lucknow. Unpublished, reported for the first time, Extremely Rare as this Series of Punch-marked coins were never reported earlier.*

- 11 **Punch-marked Coins, Unknown Janapada** (5th century BC), Silver, 1.12 g, ½ **Karshapana**, Four Symbols **AABC** type, with a Triskelis (2) minted from same punch; an English 8-like Symbol, and a hare jumping to right. Reported from a village called Koch, located near Kanpur. *Unpublished, reported for the first time, Extremely Rare as this Series of Punch-marked coins were never reported earlier.*

- 12 **Punch-marked Coins, Panchala Janapada** (5th century BC), Silver, 1.98 g, ½ **Vimshatika** standard, single composite symbol type with a Lotus symbol on obv, *Unifaced. About Extremely Fine for the type, Scarce.*

- 13 **Punch-marked Coins, Panchala Janapada** (5th century BC), Silver, 1.94 g, 19 x 12 mm, ½ **Vimshatika** standard, single composite symbol type with a Lotus-like symbol on obv, two minute counter-marks, a Triskeli and a group of five dots around a central dot; the impact of the two shroff amrks was so high that the coin has resulted in scyphate shape. *Very Fine for the type, Rare.*

- 14 **Punch-marked Coins, Shurasena Janapada** (5th century BC), Silver, 0.36 g, **Mashaka**, Single-composite Punch type, made of a fish placed over a lion standing on a mountain with minor marks on right, unifaced (Rajgor Series# 77). *Very Fine+, Scarce.*

- 15 **Punch-marked Coins, Shurasena Janapada** (5th century BC), Silver, 1.45 g, ½ **Karshapana**, Single-composite Punch type, made of a fish placed over a lion standing on a mountain with a big Taurine mark on right, unifaced (Rajgor Series# 76). *Very Fine+, Rare.*

- 21 **Punch-marked Coins of Narmada Region** (2nd century BC), Copper, 4.52 g, four punch type with four punches having a river and fishes-turtles in it at the bottom, a triangle-headed Standard in railing on the left, a Turine symbol on the right and probably Brahmi legend at top-left on obv, *unifaced. Fine+, Scarce.*

- 22 **Indo-Greeks, Apollodotus II**, Silver, Drachm, bust of the ruler to right and Greek legend around on obv, Palas standing to left carrying a thunderbolt and a shield in the centre, Kharoshthi legend around on rev. *About Extremely Fine, Scarce.*

- 23 **Indo-Parthians, Gondophares** (AD 20-50), Billon, 9.1 g, **Tetradrachm**, king mounted on obv to right and Greek legend around; Lord Shiva standing to left holding a long trident and Kharoshthi legend around on rev, Northern Chach region (Mitch# 2577).

Indo-Parthian coins are generally found with the depiction of Greek deities like Zeus, Nike or Poseidion; whereas the ones with Hindu God Shiva are very rarely found. Very Fine, Very Rare.

- 24 **Dutta Rajas of Mathura, Shivadutta** (1st century BC), Copper, 16.26 g, a tree in railing in the centre and Brahmi legend Rajno Shivaduttasa around on obv, a deity in an archaic temple on rev. *Fine+, Rare.*

- 25 **Anandas of Karwar (Maharashtra), Mulananda** (1st century BC), Lead, 16.66 g, Brahmi legend **Rajno Mudanandas** atop a 7-arched hill on obv, a tree in railing with ancillary symbols around on rev. *Deep striking, About Extremely Fine for the type, Scarce.*

- 26 **Malayman Chiefs of Tamil Nadu, Sangam Age**, 1st century BC, Copper, 3.04 g, a horse standing to right and a Shrivatsa symbol on its back on obv, an ancient Map of the capital of the Malayman Chiefs with three mountains on the top, and a river flowing from the mountains at centre on rev (Mitch# 206). *Extremely Fine for the type, Rare*

- 28 **Kushana Empire, Vima Kadphises**, Copper, 16.77 g, **Tetradrachm**, Shiva-Nandi type with king standing on obv and Greeko-Kushano legend on rev, Lord Shiva standing, resting his left hand on the hump of his vehicle Nandi Bull and holding a long trishul in his right hand. This is the First Monolingual Series of the Kushanas wherein the introduction of Kharoshthi script was not introduced till then (Gobl# 760.1). *Patinated, Very Fine, Scarce.*

- 29 **Kushana Empire, Vima Kadphises**, Copper, 16.23 g, **Tetradrachm**, Shiva-Nandi type with king standing on obv and Greeko-Kushano legend on rev, Lord Shiva standing, resting his left hand on the hump of his vehicle Nandi Bull and holding a long trishul in his right hand, and Kharoshthi script around, which is basically translation and transliteration of the Greek legend on obv. Bi-lingual Series. Nearly complete Greek legend on obv. *Very Fine, Scarce.*

- 30 **Kushana Empire, Kanishka I**, Copper (6), **Set of 6 assorted Hindu and Iranian Gods**, including Shiva, Nana, Sun Moon, Wind and God of Metals. *Very Fine, Scarce. 6 coins*

- 31 **Kushana Empire, Vima Takto alias Soter Megas** (1st century AD), Copper, 7.59 g, diademed bust of the tuler to right and holding a scepter in his right hand, Tamgha in the left field behind his head on obv, Horseman king to right and Kharoshthi legend around on rev. *Very Fine+, Scarce.*

- 32 **Kushana Empire**, Copper (12), Huvishka (10), and Vasudeva (2), Set of 12 assorted Hindu and Iranian Gods and various types. *Very Fine, Scarce. 12 coins*

- 33 **Western Kshatrapas, Vijaysen** (3rd century AD), Silver (2), **Drachm, Portrait type**, as Mahakshatrapa, three arched hill in centre and a crescent on left while a Sun on the right of the hill symbol and Brahmi legend around on rev, various dates Saka 170 and 171. *Very Fine, Rare. 2 coins*

- 34 **Western Kshatrapas, Vijaysen** (3rd century AD), Silver (2), **Drachm, Portrait type**, as Mahakshatrapa, three arched hill in centre and a crescent on left while a Sun on the right of the hill symbol and Brahmi legend around on rev, various dates Saka 173 and 175. *Very Fine, Rare. 2 coins*

- 35 **Chauhans of Shakambhari and Ajayameru, Ajeya Deva** (c. AD 1110-20), Billon, **Dramma**, seated goddess Lakshmi facing front on obv. Devanagari *sri aja / yap ala / devah* in three lines on rev (Deyell 178). *Very Fine+, Scarce.*

- 36 **Chauhans of Ajmer, Chahada Deva** (c. AD 1172-1191), Billon, **Dramma**, or Bull & Horseman type, a recumbent Bull facing left, tined Trishula on bull's rump, numeral 1 on the bull's jhula, Nagari legend on the left and above, *Asvari / Shri Samanta deva* in arc on obverse; a horse-rider bearing lance on a caparisoned horse, facing right, with three dots of harness on horse's rump; Nagari legend on left and right, *Shri Cha / hada deva* (Deyell# 220). *About Excellent condition, the complete legends on both the sides make the coin important and collectible.*

Chahada Deva was an heir-apparent (*Yuvaraj*) to the throne of Ajmer and Delhi and the predecessor of the famous Prithiviraj III of the Prithiviraj-Sanyukta fame.

- 37 **Chauhans of Ajmer, Prithviraj III** (AD 1179-1192), Billon, **Dramma** or Bull & Horseman type, a recumbent Bull facing left, tined Trishula on bull's rump, numeral 1 on the bull's jhula, Nagari legend on the left and above, *Asvari / Shri Samanta deva* in arc on obverse; a horse-rider bearing lance on a caparisoned horse, facing right, with three dots of harness on horse's rump; Nagari legend on left and right, *Shri Pri / thvi raja deva* (Deyell# 225). *About Excellent condition, the complete legends on both the sides make the coin important and collectible.*

The coin is important, it belongs to the famous Prithiviraj III of the Prithiviraj-Sanyukta fame.

39 **Kalachuris of Tripuri, Gangeya Deva** (1015-1040), Gold, 3.69 g, **Dramma**, Goddess Lakshmi seated wearing a head gear and necklace on obv, legend *Srimad Gangeya Deva* in Nagari on rev (Deyell# 145). *About Extremely Fine, Scarce.*

The silver and gold coins of Jaisalmer are divided into 3 types: In the name of Muhammad Shah, in the name of Victoria Queen, and in the name of Victoria Queen with an addition of Bird and *Chhatra* symbols. Coins of all the three types are known, apart from the regular round shape, in various shapes like square, hexagonal, octagonal, and irregular polygons. These odd shapes of Rupees and Mohurs were made by cutting from metal bars and then hammering into shapes required. 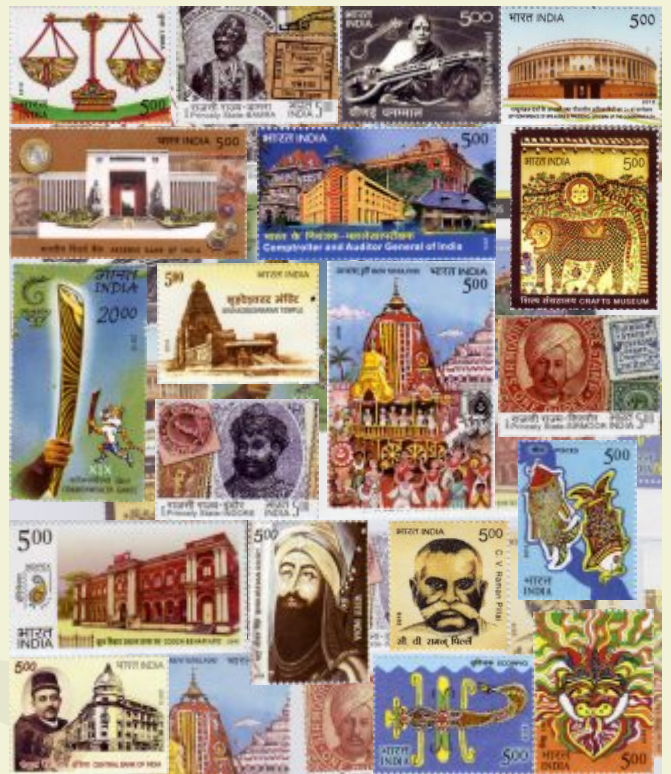

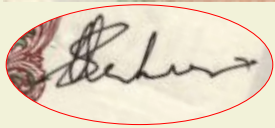

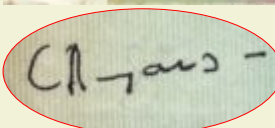
