**Registration of Coins:** According to the Antiquities and Art Treasure Rules 1973 of the Antiquities and Art Treasures Act, 1972 (Act No. 52 of 1972), and Amendment S.O. 448 (E), dated 2.7.1976 as amended by S.O. 397 (E), dated 15.5.1980, all coins and Numismatic materials are EXCLUDED from the Compulsory Registration of Antiquities.

Hence a person residing in India can collect any number of numismatic materials like coins, tokens, medals, banknotes and paper money, without having any restrictions of Registering them with the Government of India.

## Ancient Coins (600 BC to AD 700)



1 ₹ 1,200  
**Swastika Coin, Ancient Saurashtra (Gujarat), c. 50 BC**, Copper, 7.05 g, anonymous, uninscribed, typical Ujjayini-type motifs depicting Lord Mahakaal (the deadly Form of Lord Shiva as a God of Death) holding a staff (*Danda*) and a water-pot (*Kamandalu*), the two signs of Punishment and Water of Life, and a six-armed symbol representing on-going cycle of Life and Death on obv. The rev is depicting two angular Swastika (*Svastika*) placed side by side with the end-points having the form of Shrivatsa symbol. *Unusual shape and beautiful green patina occurred due to remaining in river water for a prolonged time. Attractive, photogenic and Scarce.*

The earliest reference of Swastika is found in the *Yajura Veda*, dated to about 10,000 BC. The Shlok praising the form of Swastika is still enchanted by Pandits during marriages and in the auspicious occasions. It reads as -

*Swasti na Indro Vruddhastravaha Svastinah pusha  
Vishvavedaha!*

*Swasti nastakshya Arishtanemihi Svastino Bruhaspatirdadhatu!  
- Yajura Veda (c. 10,000 BC)*

This famous Shloka defines the Swastika by saying:  
 “May Almighty God of infinite glory be auspicious to us,  
 May the All-Knowing Lord of the Universe be of auspiciousness to us;  
 May the Powerful Protection of the Universe bring auspiciousness to us,  
 May the Lord of Lords, The Supreme Being bring fortune to us.”



2 ₹ 4,500  
**Punch-marked Coins, Kosala Janapada** (5th century BC), Silver, 1.68 g, ½ **Karshapana**, AABB type 4 symbols with the first pair of the symbol consisting of a lotus and the second of a triskeli. A six-armed symbol counter-marked on rev. *Very Fine+, Unpublished and Unique reported here for the first time.*

The coin is similar to the Series 62, Karshapana coins as described by Rajgor, however, the present coin is a half of the said Rare series of coins which were never reported earlier. Even the known 3 coins of this type of full denomination are housed only in museums, Lucknow Museum and Bharat Kala Bhavan, Varanasi. Hence the discovery of this coin is new and unique.



3 ₹ 3,500  
**Punch-marked Coins, Ashmaka Janapada** (5th century BC), Silver, 1.37 g, ½ **Karshapana**, four symbols type of ABCC type, *unifaced. Extremely Fine, Scarce.*



4 ₹ 1,000  
**Punch-marked Coins, Surashtra Janapada** (5th century BC), Silver, 0.90 g, 1/4 **Karshapana**, **Shrivatsa** type with a big central symbol of a Shrivatsa, representing Goddess Lakshmi in the centre placed on a square box and ancillary symbols around. *Traces of under-type still visible. Very Fine+ for the type, Scarce.*



5 ₹ 2,500  
**Punch-marked Coins, Anga Janapada** (3rd century BC), Copper, 11.79 g, punch-marks on both the sides of the coin. Ascribed to Anga Janapada in modern Bihar State. *About Very Fine, Scarce.*



6 ₹ 1,200  
**Punch-marked Coins, Post-Mauryas** (3rd century BC), Silver, **Karshapana**, 5+1 symbols type with 5 different symbols on obv, and the sixth symbol of an elephant to right with taurines around, and an additional symbol, No. 7 consisting of a caduceous (G&H# 566). *About Very Fine, Scarce. (3 coins)*



7 ₹ 4,500  
**Punch-marked Coins Eran-Vidisha Region**, 2nd century BC, Copper, 3.60 g, punch-marked type with 5 + 1 Symbols type. The obv has five punches struck from five different punches consisting of a flowing river with fishes and turtles insides, placed at the bottom of the coin; a horse walking to right placed at the left; a six-armed symbol, placed at the top; a tree-in-railing at the centre, and the fifth symbol consisting of a human figure standing on the right edge of the coin. Rev consists of the famous Ujjayini symbol with double orbs.

This usually common-looking punch-marked coin is very important for the fact that it has the fifth symbol of a human figure. The figure looks like a Hindu monk, carrying a mace (Danda) in his right hand, and a Water-Pot (Kamandalu) in the left hand. Similar figures are generally found on the die-struck coins of Ujjayini of about 200-100 BC era. This is the earliest example of such a figure appearing on the Punch-marked coins. Identification of this figure is also worth considering. The provenance of all such coins is Ujjain, which houses the famous temple of Mahakaal, the God of Death and Time. Mahakaal according to Hindu mythology is a monk wandering in jungles and carrying his staff and a water-pot. The description and origin of the figure confirms the identification of his as God Mahakaal (a form of Lord Shiva). Unusual, Rare and Unpublished.



8 ₹ 2,500  
**Kaushambi** (2nd century BC), Copper, 1.26 g, **Damaru Coin** with a figure of a nude lady standing front, and a triangle-Headed Standard in a railing, symbolizing Hindu God Indra on rev. *About UNC for the type as these are never found in such an immaculate condition, Rare.*



9 ₹ 2,000  
**Yaudheyas** (200 BC), Copper, 10.42 g,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  **Karshapana**, War God, Six-headed Karttikeya standing facing front with spear, Brahmi legend, *Bhagvato Svamino Brahamanyadevasya* on obv, Goddess Devasena standing facing, railed tree on right hand and 10-arched hill surmounted by a Shrivatsa symbol on left (MACW 4467). *Very Fine for the type, Rare.*



10 ₹ 2,000  
**Yaudheyas** (200 BC), Copper, 8.23 g,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  **Karshapana**, War God, Six-headed Karttikeya standing facing front with spear, Brahmi legend, *Bhagvato Svamino Brahamanyadevasya* on obv, Goddess Devasena standing facing, railed tree on right hand and 10-arched hill surmounted by a Shrivatsa symbol on left (MACW 4467). *About Very Fine for the type, Rare.*



11 ₹ 2,000  
**Yaudheyas** (200 BC), Copper, 10.42 g,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  **Karshapana**, Festival of India-type deer standing to right, traces of Brahmi legend around on obv, 6-headed God Kartikeya standing facing in centre on rev. *About Very Fine for the type, Rare.*



12 ₹ 2,000  
**Indo-Greeks, Philoxenus** (100-95 BC), Copper, 8.25 g, Square Unit, City-Goddess standing to left and holding a cornucopia, the Horn of Fulfillment on obv. with Greek legend around three sides; a humped bull standing to right with Kharoshthi legend on three sides on rev (Bope Series 10). *Almost UNC, Rare in this grade.*



13 ₹ 2,200  
Indo-Greeks, **Menander I** (2nd century BC), **Copper**, 2.76 g, Elephant type with head of the elephant to right and Greek legend around on obv, mace in centre and Kharoshthi around on rev. *Extremely Fine+ with green patina, Scarce.*



14 ₹ 1,800  
Indo-Greeks, **Apollodotus II** (2nd century BC), **Copper**, 8.59 g, Greek God Apollo standing to front holding his tripod in the centre with Greek legend around on obv, Tripod of Apollo placed in the centre within a dotted circle and Kharoshthi legend around on rev. *A local issue of Saurashtra mint, About Very Fine for the type, Scarce.*

15 ₹ 4,500  
Indo-Greeks, Apollodotus II, **Silver, Drachma**, portrait type with bust of the ruler to right in the centre and Greek legend around on obv, Greek Goddess in the centre facing left and Kharoshthi legend around on rev. *Uncleaned with original soil and patina, Very Fine, Scarce. (5 coins)*



16 ₹ 3,500  
Taxila (2nd century BC), **Copper**, 9.78 g, punch-marked type with a single composite symbol consisting of a three-arched Stupa and a tree in railing. *Unifaced, Extremely Fine+, Rare.*



17 ₹ 2,500  
**Taxila** (2nd century BS), **Copper**, 1.89 g, three arched hill and hollow cross on obv, ornate tree in railing on rev. *Anonymous, About Very Fine, Rare.*



18 ₹ 1,500  
**Indo-Scythians, Azes**, 1st century BC, **Copper**, 2.44 g, Horseman type with king riding a horse to right and Greek legend around on obv, Greek God carrying Scales to left and Kharoshthi legend around on rev. *Very Fine for the type, Scarce.*



19 ₹ 2,000  
**Pallavas of Kanchi**, 2nd century AD, **Copper**, 1.63 g, a walking bull to right with early Brahmi characters above its back on obv, a Dharmachakra (Wheel of Religion) on rev. *About UNC for the type, Rare in this grade.*



20 ₹ 2,600  
Pallavas of Kanchi, 3rd century AD, **Copper**, 1.25 g, a bull standing to right placed in a radiant circle on obv, a motif made of solid dots on rev, anonymous. *Extremely Fine+, Rare.*



21 ₹ 1,900  
**Satavahanas, Satakarni I** (1st century AD), **Copper**, 2.18 g, a bull standing to right with Brahmi legend at top. *About Very Fine, Scarce.*



22 ₹ 3,000  
**Sadakana Maharathis of Chandravalli** (1st century BC), Sadakana Kalalaya, **Lead**, 12.22 g, a humped bull standing to left Brahmi legend *Mahavathisa Sadakanam Kalalaya* on obv, a tree in railing to left, and a crescented on hill on right on rev. *About Extremely Fine for the type, Rare*



23 ₹ 3,000  
**Kuras of Karwar** (Maharashtra), **Vasithiputra Kura** (1st century BC), Lead, 13.47 g, bow and arrow in the centre and Brahmi legend around, *rajno vasithiputrasa kurasa* on obv; tree in railing and Stupa symbols on rev. *Extremely Fine for the type, Rare.*



24 ₹ 2,000  
**Kushanas, Wima Takto** *alias* **Soter Megas**, 2nd century AD, Copper, 8.33 **1 Unit**, helmeted bust of the king to right on obv, a horseman to right with Greek legend around on rev. *About UNC, Scarce in this grade.*



25 ₹ 2,700  
**Western Kshatrapas, Kshaharatas, Nahapana** (1st century AD), Silver, **Dramma**, portrait type with the Greek legend around on obv, thunderbolt and arrow in centre and legends in Brahmi and Kharoshthi around on rev. *The first coin is centrally struck with nearly complete Greek legend on obv, Very Fine, Scarce. (3 coins)*



26 ₹ 1,400  
**Western Kshatrapas, Kardamakas, Silver, Dramma, Rudradaman I and Rudrasimha I** (2). As Kshatrapa and Mahakshatrapas, portrait type. *About Extremely Fine, Scarce. (3 coins)*



27 ₹ 1,500  
**Western Kshatrapas, Ishvaradutta, Silver, Dramma, As Mahakshatrapa, Year 1, Prathme** (the First Year), portrait type. *Full date on obv and Extremely Fine and Better, Scarce.*



28 ₹ 5,000  
**Western Kshatrapas, Simhasena, Sister's Son of Rudrasena III** (4th century AD), Silver, **Dramma**, portrait type, as Mahakshatrapa, Saka Varshe 30x. *Very Fine+, Rare.*



29 ₹ 3,500  
**Western Kshatrapas, Rudrasena IV, son of Simhasena** (4th century AD), Silver, **Dramma**, portrait type, as Mahakshatrapa. *Very Fine+, Rare.*

30 ₹ 1,800  
**Traikutakas, Dhrasena** (c. 3rd century AD), Silver, **Dramma**, portrait type, Brahmi legend around a central Stupa symbol on rev. *Very Fine, Rare.*



31 ₹ 4,500  
**Guptas, Chandragupta II** (AD 385-414), Copper, 0.62 g, a **Garuda** seated facing with Brahmi legend below *gupta* on obv, a portrait in the first line and Brahmi legend *Chandra* in the second line on rev. *Extremely Fine for the type, Rare.*



32 ₹ 8,500  
**Guptas, Kumaragupta I** (AD 414-455), Copper, 2.45 g, **Gold Dinar-type king standing** to left and probably offering *havi* to Fire Altar on obv, Brahmi legend under a horizontal line reading *Shri Kumara* on rev. *Extremely Fine+, Very Rare.*



33 ₹ 9000  
**Hephthalites** (AD 475-576), Silver, 2.95 g, **Drachma**, Kabul valley & Zabul with winged Bull Headdress on obv, Fire Altar on rev (Mitch# 1507-09). *NGS Certified as AU55, Rare.*





34 ₹75,000  
**Kushano-Bengal of Mainamati** (5th century AD), Gold, 6.17 g, **Dinar**, Kushana style king standing to left holding bow and arrow on obv, **Goddess Ardoxo** standing to right holding a cornucopia and corrupt legend in right field on rev. *About Extremely Fine, Rare.*



35 ₹8,000  
**Kalachuris of Western India**, Silver, 0.44 g, Elephant rider to right on obv, Lord Buddha seated in a *Padmashan* posture with long ear lobes indicating divinity and traces of Brahmi legend around. *Very Fine+, unreported and Rare.*

## Hindu Coins of Medieval India (AD 700 to 1600)



36 ₹2,000  
**Vishnukundins**, 8th century AD, Copper, 2.42 g, a bull standing to right within a circle and enclosed by a dotted border on obv, a conical stylized conch shell within a radiant circle on rev. *Very Fine+, Scarce.*



37 ₹12,500  
**Yadavas of Devagiri, Bhillam Dev V**, Gold, 3.76 g, **Padmatanka**, punch-marked type with five punches, lotus in centre, Shankha, Nagari legend (*Shri Bhilla*)*ma Deva* and two punches of *Shri* in Kannada (Mitch K&A 289). *Looks like restruck on an earlier coin, About Extremely Fine, Scarce.*



38 ₹4,000  
**Hindu Kashmir, Kidarites, Pratapaditya II** (c. 5<sup>th</sup> Century AD), base Gold, Dinar, a highly stylized King standing facing, sacrificing at altar, Brahmi legend *Kidara* under arm on obv. Seated Goddess Ardoxsho in centre, Brahmi legend, *Sri Pratapa* (MACW 3638-43). *Very Fine, Scarce.*



39 ₹5,000  
**Hindu Kashmir, Kidarites, Vigrahadeva**, (c. 5<sup>th</sup> Century AD), base Gold, Dinar, a highly stylized King standing facing, sacrificing at altar, Brahmi legend *Kidara* under arm on obv. Seated Goddess Ardoxsho in centre, Brahmi legend, *Sri Vigraha*. (MACW 3650). *Deep strike, About Extremely Fine. The coins of Vigrahadeva are Rare.*



40 ₹7,000  
**Imperial Cholas, Raja Raja I** (AD 985-1014), Gold, 0.75 g, **Fanam**, king standing looking right on obv, Nagari legend *Jaya Konda* on rev (Ganesh No. 1.8). *Broad flan, uncleaned with original soil, Extremely Fine+, Scarce.*



41 ₹1,900  
**Kadambas of Hangal, Anonymous** (10th century AD), Gold, 0.09 g, **1/4 Fanam**, an ornate lion to right with a leg holding high on obv, a motif similar to a heart shape on rev. *About UNC, Scarce.*



42 ₹5,000  
**Kalachuris of Tripuri, Gangeya Deva**, Base Gold, 3.93 and 3.94 g, **Lakshmi Dramma**, 4½ Masha, seated goddess Lakshmi on obv; *Srimad Gangeyadeva* in Nagari on rev (Deyell 119). *Extremely Fine, Scarce. (2 coins)*



43 ₹ 10,000  
**Vijayanagara Empire, Krishnaraj Deva** (AD 1509-1529), Gold, 3.42 g, **Pagoda**, Bala-Krishna seated facing front and holding laddus on obv, Nagari legend, *shri pratap krishnaraya* on rev. *Very Fine+*, *Scarce*.



44 ₹ 15,000  
**Vijayanagara Empire, Venkitapati Raya III** (c. AD 1630-1641), Gold, 3.35 g, **Pagoda**, Lord Venkateshwara (**Tirupati Balaji**) standing front on obv., Devanagari legend *Sri Venkate Svaraya Namah* on rev (Mitch# 833). *Very Fine*, *Rare*

**Akbar**, Silver, **Rupee**, **Agra mint**, Kalima type with Square-area, mint name off flan at bottom on rev, AH 985. *Test mark*, *Very Fine+*.

**Akbar**, Silver, **Rupee**, **Ahmadabad** mint, Kalima type with Square-area, mint name off flan at bottom on rev, AH 987. *Test marks*, *Very Fine+*.



53 ₹4,000  
Akbar, Silver, Square ½ **Rupee, Ahmadabad**, mint name at bottom on rev, Kalima type, Ilahi 38. *Very Fine+, Rare.*

This is the only type of Akbar's coins that continued the earlier Kalima type replacing the AH years with Ilahi years.



54 ₹3,000  
Akbar, Silver, Square ½ **Rupee, Ahmadabad**, mint name off flan at bottom on rev, Kalima type, AH 988, *test marks. Very Fine, Rare.*

55 ₹1,500  
Akbar, Silver, ½ **Rupee, Ahmadabad** mint, Allahu Akbar type, Ilahi 4x, Bahman Month. *About Very Fine, Scarce.*



56 ₹2,500

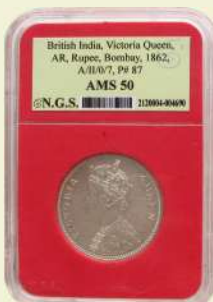

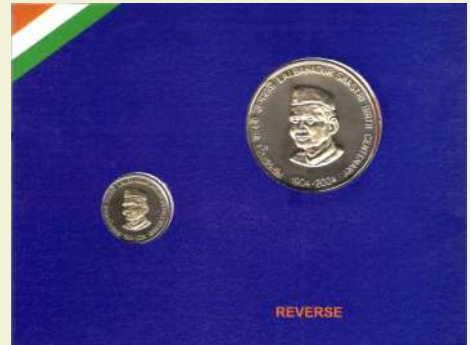

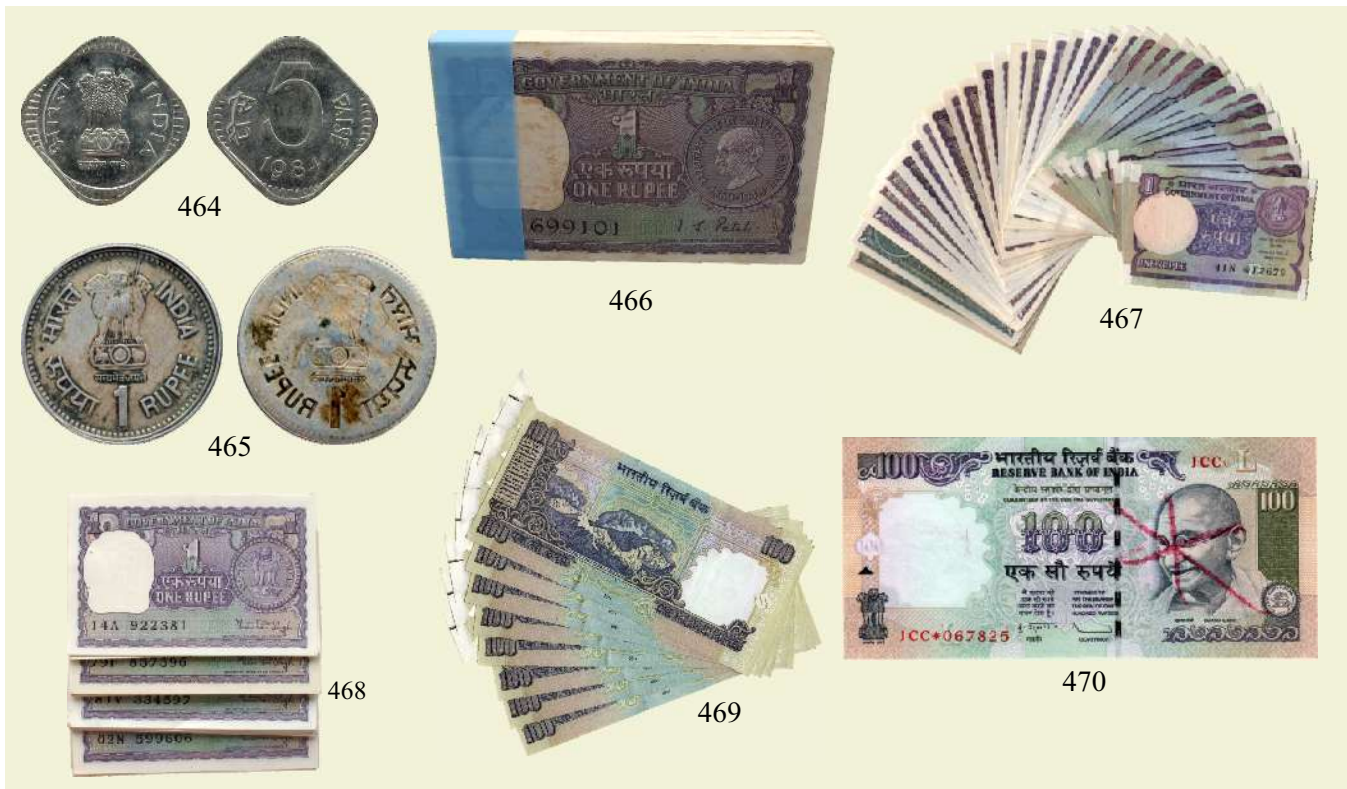
