## **Ancient Coins (600 BC to AD 700)**



1 **The Swasitka Coin, Malwa Sultanate**, Mahmud Shah bin Nasir Shah (AD 1510-1531), Silver, Tanka, AH 923 with **anti-clock Swastika** on rev. *Very Fine+*, *Rare*.

Estimate: ₹2,000-3,000



The Swastika Coin, Parat Rajas of Baluchistan, Miratakhma Son of Hvaramira (c. 3<sup>rd</sup> century AD), Silver, 3.46 gr, Drachma, Parthian-style crowned bust of the ruler to left with moustache and beaded border around on obverse, a bold Swastika symbol in the centre, Kharoshthi legend around, Miratakhmasa Hvaramiraputrasa Paratarajasa on reverse (Tandon# 35-36). Extremely Fine for the weakly minted series of this type, Very Rare.

Pankaj Tandon has done an extensive research on these little-known coins and brought to light a number of rajas, types and varieties. Refer his article, The Coins of the Paratarajas: A Synthesis, in the *Supplement to ONS Journal* 205, 2010, London.

Punch-marked Coins, Shakya Janapada (6<sup>th</sup> century BC), Silver, 6.66 g, 35 x 21 mm, 5 Shana, Single punch and Scyphate type with a a bold Pentagon symbol punched heavily in the centre, small bankers' marks around on obv, unifaced (Rajgor Series# 33). *About Extremely Fine+*, *Rare in this size*.

4 **Punch-marked Coins, Shakya Janapada** (6<sup>th</sup> century BC), Silver, 6.35 g, 35 x 23 mm, **5 Shana**, Single punch and Scyphate type with a a bold symbol punched heavily in the centre, the central symbol is made of five Crescents with a dot at top and all placed around a central solid square, small bankers' marks around on obv, unifaced, irregular in shape (Rajgor Series# 33 but this symbol is not reported by him). *About Extremely Fine+*, *Rare in this size*.

The coin is important because of a unique minting technique proof it contains. The coin on obv has a rectangle piece of silver affixed on the original surface by heating treatment and subsequently punched with the royal symbol. This technique is called Laminated Flan wherein the blank planchets were weighed before punching the symbols. In rare cases the weight of the blanks was found to be lower than the stipulated standard. In such a case the only solution was to remelt the blank and make a fresh blank of the required weight. However, to save all these trouble, the mint authorities devised a unique solution wherein a piece of required metal was affixed to the existing blank and than punching it with the royal symbol. Such a techinique is found in the punchmarked coins of Shakya Janapada only and nowhere else it is repeated.

**Indo-Greek, Eucratides** (c. 170-145 BC), Silver, 0.58 g, **Obol**, helmeted bust of the king on obv; two pilloi caps and Greek legend *Basileos Eukratidou* on rev (Bop# Series 9). *Very Fine, Scarce*.

7 **Indo-Greeks, Menander I**, Silver, **Drachm**, Indian Standard, helmeted bust of the king to right with Greek legend on obv, Pallas standing left holding shield on raised right arm and hurling thunderbolt, with Kharoshti legend around on rev (Mitch# 1780). *Very Fine+*, *Rare*.

Indo-Greeks, Menander I, Silver, 9.74 g, Tetradrachma, bust of the king to right and Greek legend around on obv, Greek Goddess Palla standing left holding a shield in her left hand and hurling a thunderbolt in the right, Kharoshthi legend around on rev. Extremely Fine+, Very Rare.

9 Indo-Greeks, Lysias, Silver, Drachm, helmeted bust of the king to right with Greek legend on obv, Greek God Zeus standing in the centre, facing front, with Kharoshti legend around on rev. Extremely Fine+, Very Rare.

10 **Indo-Greeks, Philoxenos**, Silver, **Square Drachm**, helmeted bust of the king to right with Greek legend on obv, a Horseman to right, with Kharoshti legend around on rev (Mitch# 1780). *Extremely Fine+*, *Very Rare*.

11 **Indo-Greeks, Apollodotus I**, Silver, **Square Drachm**, an elephant walking to right with Greek legend on obv, a Bull walking to right, with Kharoshti legend around on rev. *Extremely Fine+*, *Rare*.

12 **Indo-Greeks, Apollodotus I**, Copper, 15.17 g, Greek God Apollo standing to left holding his tripod in the centre and Greek legend around on obv, Tripod of the God in the centre and Kharoshthi legend around on rev. *About Extremely Fine, Rare*.

13 **Indo-Greeks, Zoilas**, Silver, **Drachm**, bust of the king to right with Greek legend on obv., Pallas standing left holding shield on raised right arm and hurling thunderbolt, with Kharoshti legend around on rev. *Very Fine+*, *Very Rare*.

Estimate: ₹8,000-9,000





14 Indo-Scythians, Azes (1<sup>st</sup> century AD), Copper, 12.91 g, a Bull walking to right and Greek legend around on obv, a Tiger standing to right and Kharoshthi legend around on rev. About Extremely Fine, Rare.

Estimate: ₹2,500-3,500





15 **City State Bhadrawati** (2<sup>nd</sup> century BC), Copper, 0.92 g, an Elephant walking to right on obv, a tree in railing in the right field and Brahmi legend reading *Bhadava*... (for Bhadrawati). *Unpublised, Very Fine, Very Rare*.

Bhadravati near Chandrapur in Maharashtra is an ancinent religious city known mainly for Jain architecture. Till now no coins of this sacred city were reported but a couple of finds of these coins, although heavier than the present coin, proves the existence of Bhadravati as a City State of ancient Maharashtra.

16 **Kunindas, Amoghbhuti** (1st century BC), Silver, **Dramma**, a deer facing right and Goddess Lakshmi standing facing the deer with a lotus hovering above her head and Brahmi legend around on obv, a Chaitya, Swastika and other symbols engulfed by Kharoshthi script on rev. *Extremely Fine for the type, Scarce*.

Estimate: ₹3,000-3,500



17 **Pre-Satavahanas of Vidarbha** (2<sup>nd</sup> century BC), Copper, 1.09 g, **Goddess Lakshmi** seated on a stool with the right hand raised and the left placed on her waist on obv, an Ujjayini symbol on rev. *Very Fine for the type, Rare.*

18 **Kushana Empire, Kujula Kadphises**, Copper, 4.22 g, ½ **Unit**, Bull to right and legend around on obv, a double humped camel to right and Kharoshthi legend around on rev. *About Extremely Fine, Scarce*.

19 **Kushana Empire, Huvishka**, Copper, 13.19 g, **Tetradrachm**, king riding an elephant to right and legend around on obv, God MAO standing to left and his name in the right field on rev. *Patinated, Extremely Fine, Scarce*.

20 **Kushana Empire, Huvishka**, Gold, 7.90 g, **Dinar, Ardoxo type**, half bust of the Kushana Monarch on obv, a label reading *ARDOXSO* in left margin and the Goddess facing right on rev. *About Extremely Fine, Rare*.

21 Kushana Empire, Vasudeva I, Gold, 7.93 g, Dinar, Shiva-Nandi type, the king standing to left holding a trident in his left arm and offering havi by his right hand to an Agni Kunda and legend around on obv, Hindu God Shiva standing, facing front and holding a trident in his left hand and the extended right hand holding a Pasha, he is standing and reclining on his divine vehicle Nandi Bull who is behind him walking towards left but facing front. The label in the right field reads Osho. *About Extremely Fine, Rare*.

22 Later Kushanas, Va Sha (4th century AD), Gold, 7.64 g, Dinar, king standing to left and offering Havi to a Fire Altar and Brahmi legend in the right field near his left hand on obv; Goddess Ardoxo seated on a throne and Greek legend ARDOXO in the right field on rev (similar to GK#581.2). Almost UNC, toned, Rare in this grade.

23 **Western Kshatrapas, Vijaysen** (3<sup>rd</sup> century AD), Silver (4), **Drachm, Portrait type**, as Mahakshatrapa, three arched hill in centre and a crescent on left while a Sun on the right of the hill symbol and Brahmi legend around on rev, various dates Saka 164, 167, 168 and 169. *Very Fine, Rare.* 4 coins

26 **Hindu Shahis of Ohind (Afghanistan), Samantadeva**, Copper, 1.82 g, Elephant and Lion type with an elephant standing to left with legend above on obv, a lion galloping to right on rev (Deyell# 54). *About Very Fine, Scarce*.

27 **Kalachuris-Vakatakas, Vishnukundin type**, Copper, 1.42 g, **Lion type**, a stylized Conch Shell (*Shankha*) in the centre and two lamp-post-type pillars on either sides, representing the Attendants of the Divine *Shankha* on obv, a roaring lion standing to right in aggression, with mouth open and front-right paw raised, corrupt Brahmi characters above its back near the end of tail on rev. Deep striking, *About Extremely Fine, Rare*.

28 Kalachuris-Vakatakas, Vishnukundin type, Anonymous, Copper (2), 2.61 g, 1.99 g, Bull type, an angular Conch Shell (Shankha) in the centre and two lamp-post-type pillars on either sides, for the Attendants of the Divine Shankha on obv, a Nandi Bull standing to right facing towards the bearer of the coin, without Brahmi legend a top the Bull and replaced by minor symbols on rev. Very Fine, Rare. 2 coins

29 Chalukyas of Gujarat, Siddhraj Jayasimha, Silver, 0.44 g, Hasti Dramma, an elephant walking to right with a long trunk touching the ground on obv, early Nagari legend reading on rev, Shrimad jaya si/piya. The Nagari script is bold and cruder in nature, indicating a later mintage of the Chalukyas. About Extremely Fine, Scarce.

30 **Indo-Sassanians of Malwa** (13<sup>th</sup> century), Billon, **Omkaar type**, usual degenerated bust of the king to right with Nagari *Ja* on obv, Nagari legend *Shri Om / Kar* on rev (Deyell# 172). *About Extremely Fine, Scarce*.

Estimate: ₹1,200-1,500

31 **Indo-Sassanians of Malwa** (13<sup>th</sup> century), Billon, **Shri type**, usual degenerated bust of the king to right with Nagari *Ja* on obv, Nagari legend *Shri* on rev (Deyell# 177). *Very Fine, Scarce*.

Estimate: ₹1,000-1,200



Chalukyas of Kalyana, 11<sup>th</sup> century AD, Gold, 3.80 g, Pagoda, Punch-marked type, nine punches including five of lion to left, and one with Vaishnavite symbols of Chakra and Shankha (cf. Mitch# 276). *Unifaced. Very Fine+*, *Rare.*

33 **Indo-Sassanians, Sind**, c. 7<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> century AD), Base Gold, 7.00 g, **Dinar**, Sasanian style bust, wearing winged head-dress, and a shield to right on obv; fire altar flanked by two attendants on either side on rev. A small chisel mark across the bust, weak die of obv but a sharp die on rev. *Very Fine+ for the type, Rare*.

Estimate: ₹30,000-33,000



34 **Rashtrakutas of Western India, Guna Tunga,** c. 8<sup>th</sup> century AD, Silver, 0.14 g, **Dramma**. Profile bust of king to right on obv, Brahmi inscription *Sri Guna Tunga* on rev. *Very Fine for the type, Rare*.

Estimate: ₹1,500-2,000









35 Chandelas of Bundelkhand, Madanvarman (1129-1163), Gold (2), 3.93 and 1.03 g, Dramma and ¼ Dramma, Lakshmi type, Nagari legend on rev. First is About Extremely Fine, second is Very Fine, Rare as a set of 2 denominations.

Estimate: ₹10,000-12,000





36 **Rajas of Cochin**,  $16^{th} - 17^{th}$  centuries, Gold, 0.38 g, **Fanam**, Vira Raya type, lion on obv, Boar and dots on rev (Herrli# 1.14.01). *Almost UNC, Scarce*.

37 Jalal ud din Muhammad Shah (AD 1418-1432), Silver, 0.69 g, 1/16 Tanka, Jalal ud duniya wa ud din Muhammad shah in Tughra characters on obv, Abu al Muzaffar legend on rev. The obverse is similar to G&G# B383 while the reverse is similar to G&G# B378. But this combination and this smallest denomination is published here for the first time, Unpublished, Unique.

38 **Sikandar Shah bin Ilyas Shah**, Silver, **Tanka**, **Firuzabad mint**, Hexagonal area on obv and circular area on rev, AH 781. *Very Fine+*, *Scarce*.

39 **Ala ud Din Hussain Shah**, Silver, **Nazarana Tanka**, **Dar-ul-Darb** Mint (Rajgor# 486; G&G# B761). *A number of counter-marks, About Very Fine, Scarce*.

40 Ala ud Din Hussain Shah (AD 1493-1519; AH 899-925), Gold, 10.67 g, Victory Tanka, Fathabad mint, 4<sup>th</sup> Victory Coin, with an interesting legend reading through both the sides: al-sultan al-fath al-kamra wa kamta wa jajnagar wa urissa ala ud duniya wa ud din abu al muzaffar / hussain shah al-sultan bin sayyid ashraf al-husaini khalda allah mulkahu wa sultanhu, AH 899 (G&G# B726). Extremely Fine+, rated RRR by Goron & Goenka.

Legends on both the sides are placed in double circels, AH 934 with garbled characters on the right, probably an imitation of a mint name.

The coin is similar to G&G# B796 but it has additional double circles and a very fine calligraphy as compared to the listed coin. Centrally struck with deep striking, Unpublished and Mint State, Unique.

The disintegration of the Mughal Empire, exposed the town of Sirhind to continual attacks. Nadir Shah struck a silver coin at Sahrind on his return journey frm Delhi which bears a new epithet, Dar ul Aman, Abode of Security. Sahrind was repeatedly occupied by Ahmad Shah as apart of his Punjab invasion; an issue of his first year testifies to a battle fought in this vicinity within ten months of assassination of Nadir Shah. The temporary Durrani coinage in Sahrind was succeded by the Mughals in AH 1161. The year 1161 (AD 1747) was also the first regnal year of the Mughal Emperor Ahmad Shah Bahadur who struck money at Sahrind in this and each of the five following years.

The present coin is one such of 4 known coins in Lahore Museum, which was issued by Ahmad Shah Abdali during his invasion of Sahrind in Punjab.
