Ancient Coins (600 BC to AD 700)



- 1 **The Ganesha Coin, Nayakas of Madurai, 18th century, Copper, 3.49 g, Head of Lord Ganesha facing front with a large trunk in the centre, Tamil legend in the right field reading *Sri Vira* on obv; Goddess Meenakshi (Parvati and mother of Lord Ganapati) standing and facing front within a circle and dotted border on obv. *Very Fine, Rare***

- 2 **The Ganesha Coin, Thailand, Rama VI, 10 Baht, Bi-metal, 2012, portrait of the ruler to left on obv, Lord Ganapati seated in the centre with four hands and holding various *Ayudhas*, value around on rev. Commemorating the 100 years of Department of Arts, Thai Era 2554 (2012). *Brilliant UNC.***

- 3 **Ancient Bead Money (3rd century BC), Gold, 1.99 g, Ujjain region, the gold money in the shape of a circular bead or a locket has a huge circular hole in the centre, and around is totally plain as is usually found on these money pieces, however, on this item three dots in the shape of a triangle are marked making it an interesting piece of monetary history. *The present money seems to be a precursor to coined money and is a transitional phase of uncoined and coined money. Interesting and Rare.***

- 4 **Punch-marked Coins, Surashtra Janapada (5th century BC), Silver, 0.95 g, ¼ Karshapana, Single symbol type, uniface, a bold *Shrivatsa* symbol representing Goddess Lakshmi placed in the centre over a square pedestal with ancillary symbols around on obv. *About Extremely Fine, Scarce.***

- 5 **Punch-marked coins, Kosala Janapada (c 525-465 BC), Silver, *Vimshatika*, four symbol type with four-U symbol, a Star and two punches of a Triskeli. Minute shroff marks on rev (Rajgor Series 60, #945). *Very Fine, Scarce.***

- 6 **Punch-marked coins, Magadha Janapada (5th century BC), Silver, *Karshapana*, five symbol series, First Series of the I-XXI-A-1 type (G&H# 148). *Extremely Fine, Rare in this condition.***

- 7 **Punch-marked Coins, Post-Mauryas (2nd century BC), Silver, *Karshapana*, 5+1 Symbols type, with the **figure of Lord Balaram** (elder brother of Lord Krishna), the five obverse symbols include a sun, six-armed symbol, a Sanyasi (Lord Shiva) standing over a bull to right, a square with four compartments, and Lord Balaram standing with holding a mace in his right hand and holding a Plough (Hal) in his left hand over his shoulder. The sixth symbol on the reverse includes a Sanyasi with a head-gear and holding a Staff in his left hand and a *Kamandalu* in his right hand. *Almost Mint State, Rare in this grade.***

- 8 **Indo-Greeks, Apollodotus I (180-160 BC), Copper, 9.02 g, Greek God Apollo standing to left holding a bow and an arrow, with Greek legend around on obv, Tripod of the God Apollo in the central dotted square and Kharoshthi legend around on rev. *About Extremely Fine, Scarce.***

- 9 Indo-Greeks, **Menander I** (155-130 BC), Silver, 2.43 g, **Drachm**, diademed bust of the ruler to right with Greek legend around on obv, Goddess Athena to left holding a thunderbolt and a shield to left with Kharoshthi legend around on rev. *About Extremely Fine, Scarce.*

- 10 Indo-Greeks, **Menander I** (155-130 BC), Silver, 2.40 g, **Drachm**, diademed bust of the ruler to right with Greek legend around on obv, Goddess Athena to left holding a thunderbolt and a shield to left with Kharoshthi legend around on rev. *Extremely Fine, Scarce.*

Estimate: ₹ 2,000-2,500



- 11 Indo-Greeks, **Diomedes** (95-90 BC), Silver, 2.26 g, **Drachm**, helmeted bust of the ruler to right with Greek legend around on obv, Dioscures (2 deities) standing front, holding long scepters, with Kharoshthi legend around on rev (Bopp# Series 9). *Almost UNC with luster, Very Rare.*

- 12 Indo-Greeks, **Archebios** (90-80 BC), Silver, 2.50 g, **Drachm**, diademed bust of the ruler to right with Greek legend around on obv, God Zeus standing front, holding a thunderbolt in right hand and a scepter in the left, with Kharoshthi legend around on rev (Bopp# Series 5). *Extremely Fine, Rare.*

- 13 **Kaushambi** (c. 200 BC), Copper, 4.32 g, **Lanky bull type**, Bull standing to left on obv, tree in railing in centre, Ujjaini symbol, six arched hill and Swastika on rev (Bop & Piep p.119 1-12). *Fine+, Scarce.*

- 14 **Kunindas, Amoghbbhuti** (1st century BC), Copper, 2.09 g, a deer facing left and Brahmi legend around on obv, a Chaitya, Swastika and other symbols engulved by Kharoshthi script on rev. *The coin is similar to the famous poster of Festival of India. Very Fine for the type, Scarce.*

- 15 **Satavahana Empire of Maharashtra, King Satakarni with Queen Naganika** (1st century AD), Copper (bell metal), 6.79 g, obverse of the coin reads in Brahmi legend in the central tablet in the shape of a rectangle, *Nagamnikaya*. The legend above the tablet is nearly off the flan while at the bottom of the tablet reads from inside, *...kanisa*. The object in the right of the central tablet looks like a kind of railing with 2x5 square boxes. Reverse of the coin has a bold Ujjayini Symbol placed inside a square beaded border with a Swastika in each of the orbs of the Ujjayini symbol. *Extremely Fine+, Exceedingly Rare.*

This is the earliest example of a Queen issuing coins with her own name on the coins. The coin not only has a historical importance as the name and references of the Queen Naganika are profusely available in the cave inscriptions at Junnar, an important trade centre on way to Kalyan and there to the Roman Empire, but the coin also sheds an important light on the women's liberation in ancient India and the powers enjoyed by a woman.

20 **Ancient Vidarbha, Pre-Satavahana** (2nd century BC), Copper, 3.1 g, Goddess Lakshmi seated cross-legged on a lotus on obv, an Ujjayini symbol on rev. *Anonymous. About Extremely Fine for the type, Rare.*

21 **Anandas of Karwar (Maharashtra), Mulananda** (1st century BC), Lead, 11.89 g, Brahmi legend **Rajno Mudanandas** atop a 7-arched hill on obv, a tree in railing with ancillary symbols around on rev. *Deep striking, About Extremely Fine for the type, Scarce in this grade.*

22 **Anandas of Karwar (Maharashtra), Mulananda** (1st century BC), Lead, 15.63 g, heavy issue, Brahmi legend **Rajno Mudanandas** atop a 7-arched hill on obv, a tree in railing with ancillary symbols around on rev. *Deep striking, About Extremely Fine for the type, Scarce in this grade.*

23 **Ancient Deccan** (1st century BC), Copper, 2.84 g, a galloping horse to right with a star-like symbol on its back on obv, a tree in railing and a six-arched hill placed side by side on rev. *Anonymous, Very Fine+, Rare.*

28 Kushana Empire, **Kanishka I**, Copper, 4.57 g, **Ithyphalic Shiva type**, king standing to left and obv, Lord Shiva standing holding Trishul and a Kamandalu, OESHO in the right field, the coin is similar to the Ithyphalic posture found on other coins but the extra metal on that part of the coin makes the coin uncertain. *Very Fine+, Scarce.*

29 Kushana Empire, **Huvishka** (c. AD 152-192), Gold, 7.86 g, **Dinar, Goddess Oanindo type**, Mint I9A), 3rd Emission, paO (retrograde h) a (retrograde h), OPAO OO HPK {I{KOPA (retrograde H) O, nimbate, diademed and crowned half-length bust of King Huvishka to left, seated on clouds, flames at shoulders, holding a mace-scepter in right hand and filleted spear in the left hand, legend Oa (retrograde h), I (retrograde h); Winged Goddess Oanindo (Nike-Victory) standing to left, holding wreath in outstretched right hand and cradling filleted scepter in left arm; Tangha to right. MK 244 (O1/R3); Donum Burns 255. *About Extremely Fine, Exceedingly Rare.*

30 **Western Kshatrapas, Nahapana** (1st century AD), Silver, **Drachm**, portrait on obv, bi-lingual legend on rev, Greek legend around bust on obv. *Certified by NGS as MS 61 Choice. Scarce.*

31 **Western Kshatrapas, Kshaharatas, Nahapan** (1st century AD), Copper, 1.79 g, Thunderbolt and arrow on obv, a tree in railing on rev. The typical Satavahana-type coin is issued by Nahapana after his successful conquest over Maharashtra and having won the Nasik-Junnar regions, the strongholds of the Satavahanas. He issued his own coins based on the typology of the Satavahanas with the addition of his regal symbol of a thunderbolt. *About Extremely Fine, Rare.*

- 32 **Western Kshatrapas, Chashtana** (1st century AD), Silver, **Drachm, Portrait type**, bi-lingual with Brahmi and Kharoshthi legends on rev, and Greek on obv, the legend on rev reads Rajno Kshatrapas Chashtanas. As Kshatrpa, three arched hill in centre and a crescent on left while a Sun on the right of the hill symbol on rev. *Very Fine, Rare.*

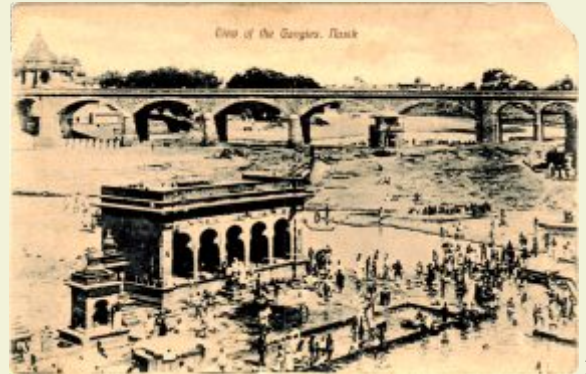
Conditions of Sale
